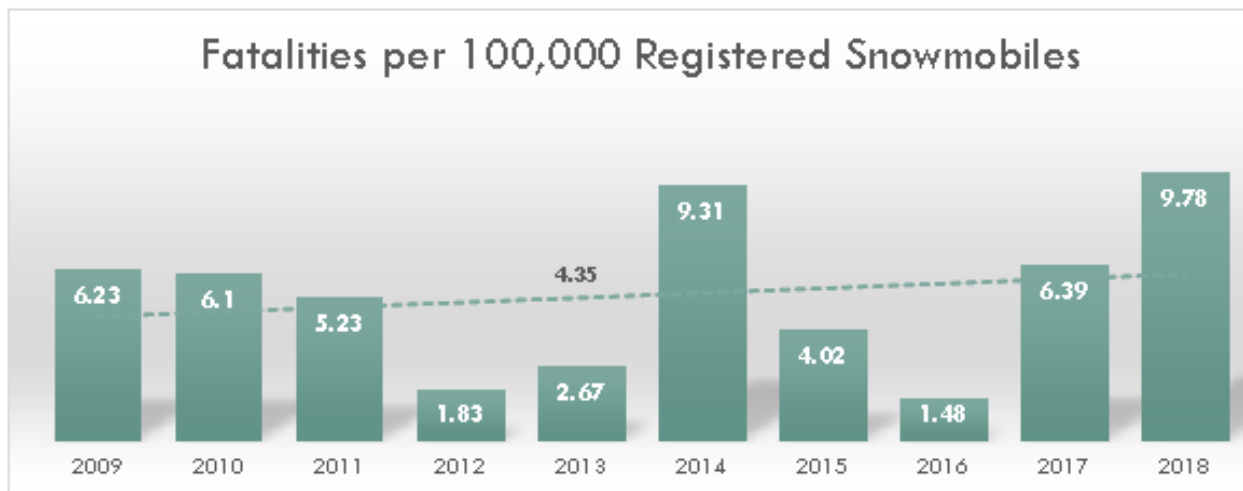
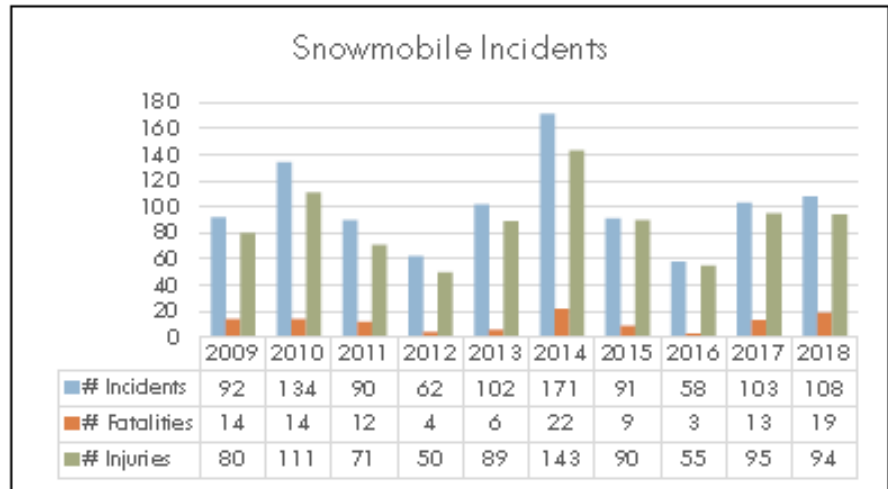
Statistics from the WI DNR 2018 Annual Program Report.
